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PRO SE DISCOVERY INFORMATION

Discovery provided with this request includes law enforcement reports and may also include other investigative documents such as medical records etc. The discovery fee for these records is based on a fee schedule adopted by the board of commissioners and varies by case type. Before releasing, witness and victim personal information must be redacted according to ORS 135.815(4). If additional reports or records are received after your initial discovery packet is provided, you will be notified by phone or email when it is ready to be picked up. The cost of this supplemental information is included in your original discovery fee (see the Washington County fee schedule for exceptions). All Discovery Fees are due 30 days from the date of receipt, unless waived.

DIGITAL EVIDENCE INFORMATION

Digital Evidence may exist in your case(s). Examples of digital evidence are body-worn camera video, 911 calls, photos, surveillance video, etc. Prior to release, witness and victim personal information must be redacted according to ORS 135.815(4). This requires all evidence to be reviewed and redacted by an attorney, law clerk or paralegal. Depending on the amount of evidence and redaction required, this process could take several hours or even several days. The cost of providing redacted evidence is based on the hourly rate for Digital Evidence Tech time and the cost of the media required to provide you with the discovery (thumb drive or hard drive). All Digital Evidence Fees are due 30 days from the date of receipt, unless waived.
